


Mark Eric Jeffries

A New and Different JCBC Bible Study "JCBC's Prayer Clinic"

After consulting with Pastor Morrow about the 7:00 PM Bible study material, it was agreed that the time had come to temporarily step away from The Wired Word's weekly lessons for something different. The Zoom platform continues to be our mode of group connection and information sharing. In January and February 2024, our 7 PM Wednesday night Bible Study focused on the topic of PRAYER in a "Prayer Clinic" learning series led by Wilhelmina Pierce, with assistance from Barbara Carter and Deacon Jerry Royster. The purposes of the prayer clinic included:

- To deepen our relationship with God and our responsiveness to the Holy Spirit
- To learn how to pray more effectively for oneself and for others, and
- To experience more of the power of prayer

Our very first JCBC "Prayer Clinic" debuted on January 17, 2024, which covered an article titled "Praying for One Another." The first prayer clinic was a Biblical overview on the importance of praying with purpose and clarity. Prayer is essential to living an effective Christian life for the Lord and for fulfilling our JCBC Purpose Statement. Subsequent weekly Prayer Clinic lessons included:

- 1) How to Not Pray Part 1 (Jan. 24)
- 2) How to Not Pray Part 2 (Jan. 31)
- 3) Intercessory Prayer (Feb. 7)
- 4) Intercessory Prayer with God's Word (Feb. 14)
- 5) Spiritual Warfare Prayer (Feb. 21)
- 6) Saturation Praying (Feb. 28).

Prayer Clinic attendees were challenged to go beyond just listening and to implement the prayer principles through weekly application exercises. Based on the discussions during Bible study, participants were very motivated by the helpful suggestions to increase and improve their prayer life. Please accept this poem as an element to motivate your prayer life:

"Prayers Can't Be Answered Unless They are Prayed"

Life without purpose is barren indeed. There can't be a harvest unless you plant seed. There can't be attainment unless there's a goal. And man's but a robot unless there's a soul.

If we send no ships out, no ships will come in.
And unless there's a contest, nobody can win.
For games can't be won unless they are played,


